

NORTHWEST REGIONAL LIBRARY
CHILDREN'S PROGRAMS POLICY

NWRL children's programs are designed to be a means to introduce young children to the library and good children's literature in a way that will encourage further reading and use of the library. The following policy is utilized to protect those children, their parents/legal guardians/designated care givers and the library staff.

Parents/legal guardians/designated care givers must deliver and pick up preschool and primary school children inside the library building. These children will not be allowed to leave the building unattended.

If a preschool or primary school child is to be picked up by someone other than a parent/legal guardian/designated care giver or is to walk home, the librarian must be notified. This exempts the library of liability for that child once the child leaves the library building.

If a child is continuously disruptive, the parent/legal guardian/designated care giver will be asked to remain during the program.
